


About articles

You may have noticed that there are no articles in Ukrainian language. The meaning of English articles a/an/the is usually conveyed by the context.

About nouns and pronouns

Ukrainian nouns have gender (masculine, feminine, neutral) and number.

Gender of Ukrainian nouns is fairly easy to define: masculine nouns usually have a consonant ending, feminine – ending \mathbf{a} or \mathbf{g} , neutral – \mathbf{o} or \mathbf{e} . Plural nouns, by rare exception, have ending \mathbf{u} or \mathbf{i} .



Pronouns that describe nouns also have gender and number and agree with the nouns.

Ukrainian verbs, just like verbs in many other languages, have conjugations, that is, depending on a personal pronoun a verb takes a different ending. You already have learned "I" and "you" form of a few verbs. You will learn more of conjugating at PST.
